
EPFL Chemical and biological wastes containing radioisotopes



¹The dose rate H*(10) measured at 10 cm from the surface should not exceed 0.1 µSv/h after subtracting the background.

Particular cases:

- For EM staining with uranium salts, follow the dedicated decision tree.
- Mix of radioisotopes with half life higher than 100 days, contact SRPO for a dedicated solution.
