



# Post-Conference Tour

Oct. 5-6, 2024

This post-conference tour is an integral part of the 33rd Conference of the International Panorama Council, hosted by the Laboratory of Experimental Museology of the EPFL, Switzerland. The attendance to the tour is optional, and subject to an additional fee

This tour constitutes the greatest opportunity to visit four Panoramas in two days. Be aware that it is unique in IPC's history! Switzerland is the perfect place for doing this because the Panoramas' proximity is relatively close to each other and it includes the oldest preserved panorama (Wocher Panorama, 1809-14).
