Arrival in Switzerland

Heading to Lausanne



- SBB Mobile app provides train/bus schedules and tickets
- Free wifi access at airport or train station by Eduroam or by mobile phone
- From Geneva airport
 There is a train station right within the airport. Trains to Lausanne run frequently from 5am to 12am (40-55 min ride).
- From Zurich airport
 Like in Geneva, there is a train station right in the airport. Trains to Lausanne run from 5am to 11:45pm (2,5 h ride).

Your train tickets can be purchased on the SBB web site https://www.sbb.ch/en/home.html. If you have mobile data in Switzerland, it might be easier to use the SBB Mobile app, which you can also use to purchase tickets for local public transport.

Public transport in Lausanne



If you are staying at a hotel, your hotel will **provide a travel card** allowing free public transport within the greater Lausanne area (trains, buses, and metros). This also covers Renens, **but does not cover Morges**.

You can also use local public transportation for free on your day of arrival (e.g. from Renens or Lausanne station to EPFL or your hotel) if you stay in a hotel or other accommodation charging tourist tax—it is sufficient to show your hotel reservation confirmation, should there be a ticket controller.

https://www.t-l.ch/map/schema. Lausanne is zone 11 et EPFL is in zone 12 but both zones are called Greater Lausanne (Grand Lausanne or GL)

You can purchase your tickets:

- on SBB Mobile app
- on SBB website https://www.sbb.ch/en/home.html
- by sending an SMS to 456: "GL" for full fare or "GLR" for half-fare (under 25 year old or with half-fare travel card). The ticket covers zone 11 & 12 (Lausanne, Renens, but <u>not</u> Morges) for 60 minutes.
- on FairTig app

One can purchase on SBB app combined public transport from A to B, including train, bus, and boat. If unsure where to get off, can use easyrider function on SBB/CFF app.

For visit over one week, consider a weekly and a monthly transport card which allows to choose zones. Lausanne 2-zone monthly travel pass is @ CHF 74.-, weekly pass at CHF 37.-. (otherwise this is CHF 3.70 per trip, or CHF 2.40 with half fare card)

If you intend to travel intensively in Lausanne or Switzerland

You may purchase a half fare card or Lausanne passes or Swiss passes. Use apps such as Fairtiq and Swiss mobile app to reduce hassles.

Swiss half fare card is available for tourists at 120CHF per month (or annual half price fare at CHF 185)

How to come to EPFL



- EPFL Campus app provides useful info on a broad range of topics
- Eduroam is available in many public places

The EPFL campus is served by metro line M1 (M1's terminal stations are in Renens and Lausanne) and by bus (from Lausanne Gare or Morges).

From Lausanne train station

Take the M1 at the starting station *Lausanne-Flon* (which is a 10 minutes walk, or a 1-minute ride on the metro line M2, from the Lausanne train station).

- Exit Lausanne train station from the north side, cross the road to take the M2.
- Take the M2 for one stop (direction *Croisettes*) and get off at Lausanne-Flon (1-minute ride).
- At Lausanne-Flon, take the M1 and get off at the stop EPFL (about 13 minutes ride).
- The mathematics department is a few minutes walk from the EPFL metro station.

Alternatively, you may take bus number 1 in front of Lausanne train station. EPFL Colladon is the terminal station. Please note that the ride is a bit longer with the bus.

From Renens station

Take the metro M1 and get off at *EPFL* station (*Renens Gare* is the starting station for M1). Approximate travel time: 6 minutes.

From Morges

Take the MBC line 701 (Direction Lausanne Bourdonnette), get off at St-Sulpice Pâqueret or St-Sulpice Science Park.

Approximate travel time: 20 min.

Amenities

- On the EPFL campus there are restaurants, cafes, grocery stores, and a bank, further details are given below, together with a list of off campus restaurants.
- There are large supermarkets (Coop and Migros) close to the main Lausanne train station (just south of it).
- The Metropole in the Flon (center of Lausanne) is a good place to find services and various shops for every day use, groceries, electronics, repairs, etc. Maxi Bazaar nearby has some inexpensive items such as glasses, mugs, etc.
- The small Coop at the Lausanne train station is open on Sundays and late into the evening.
- Coop, Migros, and Manor sell prepared meals, to be served cold or hot. It's easy to find good cheese, dry meats, and good bread. The department has a microwave on the third floor. Most hotels provide also microwave and hot water kettles either in the room or in a common area.
