




Role of FOAG in research

- Overall framework agri-food research (master plan)
- Networking/collaboration
- legal basis (Federal Act of Agriculture, Ordinance on Research)
- Agroscope: directly affiliated to FOAG
- Funding (and monitoring) research organisations, namely FiBL
- Funding of mandates
- Funding of projects

Funding of national projects

Main objectives

- Provision of a basis for decision-making in agricultural policy
- Stimulating competition in agricultural knowledge and innovation system
- Promotion of long-term research cooperation and networking

Funding is provided for

- Bottom-up ideas with relatively broad thematic coverage
- Public and private research institutions
- Applied research

Conditions

- Maximum funding of 75% of the total project budget
- Joint projects are an advantage; for organic farming it is a requirement
- 1-2 calls per year

Funding of international projects

Main objective

• Promotion of long-term research cooperation and networking

Funding is provided for

- Three cofunded partnerships (HorizonEurope) Acroecology, FutureFoodS, Agriculture of Data (in preparation)
- Swiss public and private research institutions (Swiss part is financed)

Conditions

- Selected calls for these three cofounded partnerships
- Rules of the cofounded partnerships and national conditions (e.g. maximum funding of 75% of the total project budget)
